Previous 3 years have been on a long term agreement arranged through BHIB.

Renewal quote: £836.83 (or £807.59 on 3-year agreement) this policy is underwritten by Aviva Cover arranged through Clear Councils (formerly BHIB).

Previous year cost £711.07

On enquiry, in order to obtain alternative quotes a specific re-build valuation for the War Memorial will be required. Cover arranged through BHIB insures this as a standard class of Parish Council cover (similar to other classes that you will see on our schedule some of which we do not own).

In 2021 the most cost-effective service for a re-build valuation was £165 (not taken up as policy type did not require it).

Option 1)

insure on a one-year basis with Clear Councils & consider commissioning a valuation before renewal to increase insurance options

Option 2)

insure on a three-year long -term undertaking with Clear Councils and consider commissioning a valuation before renewal

Boughton Aluph & Eastwell War Memorial fencing

Report to council 17/7/24

The grade II listed memorial is surrounded by an ornamental metal fence, included in its listing.

It has been suggested that the fencing is in need of attention. The Clerk & Councillor Coles have inspected the memorial and agree that work is needed to prevent damage and keep the memorial in good order.

Proposal: that costs are sought by the Clerk for

i.powder coating

ii.painting in situ

iii. a combination (likely that the taller uprights stay in place)

When costs have been obtained the timing (& budget year) can be decided.









Memorial bench application

Proposed commemoration: Mr & Mrs McCormack, Brenda & Raymond (also known as Mac)

late of Bumbles, Lees Road

Consideration date: 17/7/24

Eligibility: resident over five years & cricket club connection

Resident in the village (in Bumbles on Lees Road) from their retirement in 1981 until their deaths in 2021 & 2022. Active volunteers in the wider Ashford area & locally arranged various teams for special events at the cricket club between 1985 & 2010.

Other notes: Details: their family representative has expressed a preference for a recycled bench option (similar to the WW1 memorial bench). This is a more attractive recycled option than the current recycled option suggested in the bench policy so would appear to be suitable.
