Details:

The ParentKind Membership gives the Friends committee the access to lots of different positive ideas in order to benefit the children's enjoyment of their primary school experience. It also includes insurance premiums for the year allowing events to be hosted. The TENS licences allows us to put on the two main fairs of the year, which are enjoyed by the whole community and the parishioners of Boughton and Eastwell are invited to join in with these events as there many of the parishioners either have attended the school previously or have children or grandchildren who currently attend.

Benefit:

For the second-hand uniform sales, anyone with a child or grandchild at Lady Js. For the Fairs everyone.

Several children* within the parish of Boughton Aluph and Eastwell attend Lady Joanna Thornhill, access to the second-hand Uniform means parents are able to buy uniform items at a reduced cost. Ensuring all children within the school have access to the correct uniform. By being able to store these second-hand uniform items correctly, gives more opportunities to recycle and therefore benefiting the environment.

Other funding sources: Money raised throughout the year to feed back into enhancing the children's enjoyment of their time at the school.
