Terms of Use for Community Speedwatch Groups operating within the Parish Council Area

Volunteers

- All volunteers working as Operators must have completed and passed all training required by the scheme (Kent Police Community Speedwatch).
- All volunteers must be 18 or over.
- A list of volunteer names is to be provided to the Parish Council & updated as appropriate by the Community Speedwatch co-ordinator (this is required by the Parish Council Insurers) * Anyone who has not completed the required training is not covered by Parish Council insurance.
- All volunteers must adhere to the safety and operating protocols required by the Community Speedwatch scheme.

Equipment

- Equipment remains the property of the Parish Council and should be returned when requested.
- Equipment must be handled with care.
- Equipment must be made available to other approved Speedwatch groups if requested by the Parish Council.
- Equipment must not be lent or passed to any other individual, organisation or Speedwatch group without the permission of the Parish Council.

Locations

- Only locations approved by the Police Site Assessors may be used.

* This information will be used only for the administration of the Community Speedwatch Scheme, and will be shared with the Parish Council's Insurance Company if a claim or potential claim arises.
